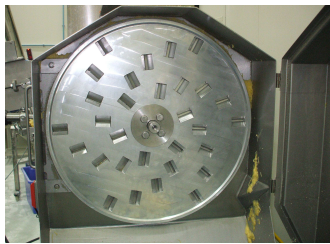
Focus on bin and crate washing
